

Credit Card ID#

For your protection, we ask that you enter an extra 3 or 4 digit number called the credit card ID number. This is not your PIN number. It is an extra number printed on your American Express, Visa, MasterCard or Discover card.

American Express: It is a four-digit number on the front of the card on the right and above the credit card number.

Visa, MasterCard and Discover: It is a three-digit number on the back of the card in the top right corner of the signature box.

Retail Pricing and Packaging/Delivery Charges for Catalog Orders

Retail prices for food products change and the catalog can become outdated rather quickly. Also packaging and delivery charges vary depending on the weight of the package and where it is going. We have therefore set the following policies for catalog orders.

1) Phone Orders: You will receive current product pricing and the packaging/delivery charge when you place your order.

2) Mail, fax and e-mail orders: A set packaging/delivery charge of \$8.50 is on the order form. We will call you with current price changes and the exact packaging/delivery charge before we put your order into our system. If you pay by charge card your card will be billed. If you pay by check the additional amount owed will show up on your statement. Since nothing is done without your verbal approval it is important that we have current and correct phone numbers so that we can contact you.

Please note that personal checks must allow at least 10 business days to clear.
